

# Consultative forum on Community Adaptation Action Plans conducted in Kendu Bay

DaCCA partner, Umande Trust conducted a consultative forum in Kendu Bay, Homabay County to deliberate on adaptation actions that would benefit the community members of Chuowe beach.

The consultative forum brought together community leaders and ward level county leaders to deliberate on the ideas collected from the community and build a solidified statement on water quality as a challenge facing the residents



Representatives were selected from five different villages in the ward and around the beach in order to strengthen the need for water quality and other priority issues that would come up from the deliberations.

Ideas collected will be drafted into Community Adaptation Action Plans (CAAPs) and after review and editing will be presented again as finished CAAPs for approval before eventual presentation to the county. The copies of the CAAPs will remain with the community to continue championing for change to the leaders and other donors as the project team follows up at the county for enactment.

The meeting was aimed at assessing the challenges pinpointed which were quality of water, pricing, sustainability models and up scaling the innovation of water filtration. The participants were also informed about the county budget cycle and the main timelines to be observed.
